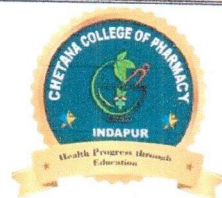

**REPORT**

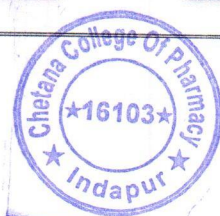
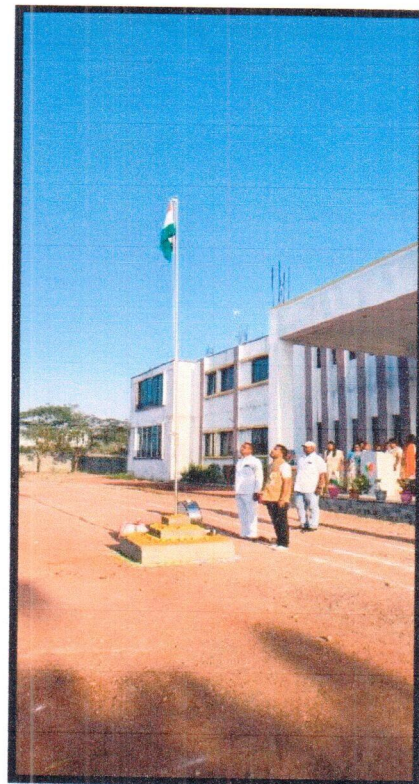

Finally, everyone took an oath to uphold the values of the Constitution on Republic Day.





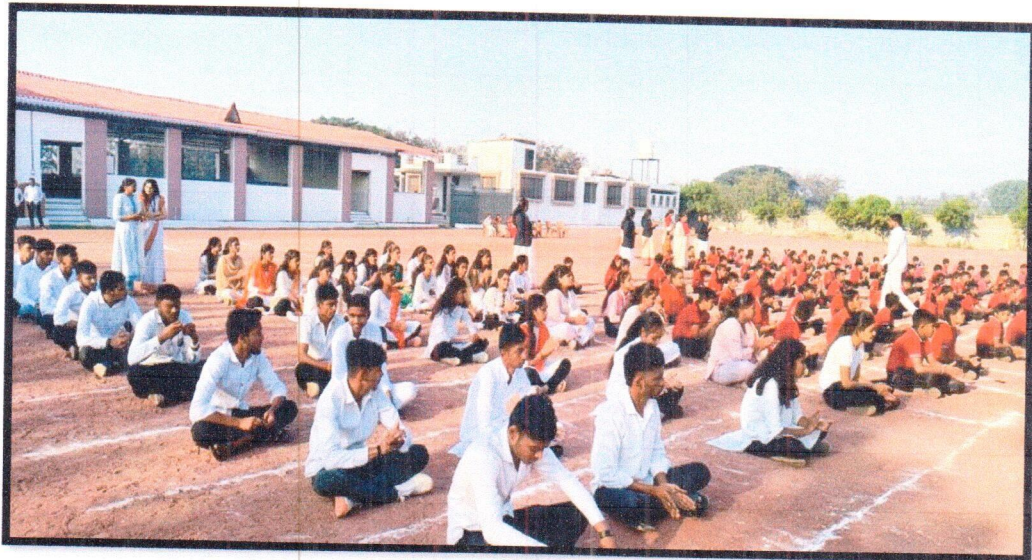

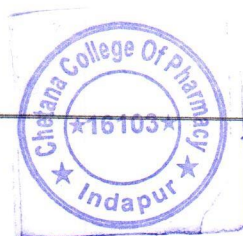
